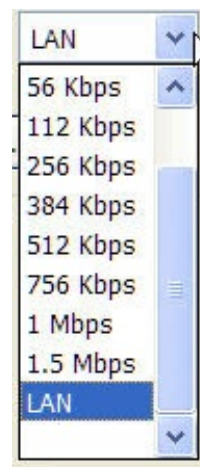
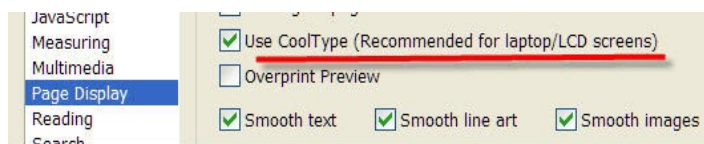


ADOBE READER PREFERENCES AND TIPS

GET THE MOST OUT OF YOUR PDF READING EXPERIENCE WITH ADOBE READER OR FOXIT READER

For most people, Adobe Reader works well with its default preference settings. However, if you experience any problems, or just want to maximize your experience with Adobe Reader check the following:

1. Use the latest version of Adobe Reader for your version of the Windows operating system. For Windows 98 users, that is major version 6.0, and for Windows XP it is major version 7.0. Minor changes are released, but are important, such as version 7.0.8.
- a. Upgrade to the current version of the reader. In so doing you take advantage of the reader's advanced features and receive the latest patches for any known problems. If you experience a problem, it may be due to a problem that was fixed in a later version of the reader.
2. Customize Adobe Reader to work best with your particular computer configuration. Open Adobe Reader, Click Edit, Preferences. **Make the following changes if needed on the General, Internet, Page Display, and Update tabs:**
 - a. **General:** Remove the checkmark for Save as optimizes for Fast Web View
 - b. **Internet:** Remove the checkmark for Allow fast web view; Remove checkmark for Allow Speculative downloading in the background (if you use dial-up to access the Internet); Place a checkmark in Display PDF in Browser to double-click on Bug-Bytes and have it open in your browser. Uncheck this option if you use another program to open your PDF files, e.g., FoxIt Reader.
 - c. **Internet, Internet Options:** Set the connection speed to agree with the speed of your Internet Connection as shown in the screen shot at the right. Pick the speed that best matches the speed offered by your ISP.
 - d. **Updates:** Pick the update method that best meets your needs and method of connecting to the Internet.
 - e. **Page display:** Enable CoolType if you have an LCD display.



FOXIT READER

Some Computerbugs will prefer an alternate PDF reader—one that is streamlined to open faster than the Adobe Reader. Remember that Adobe Reader includes a long list of plug-ins meant to work with special business applications. Foxit Reader is a good and very simple alternative reader. **It is free.** Download it from . . . http://www.foxitsoftware.com/pdf/rd_intro.php
